

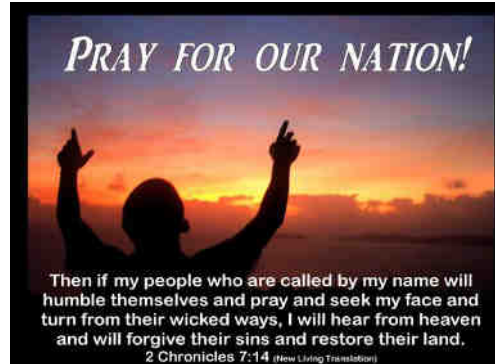
Prayer Page

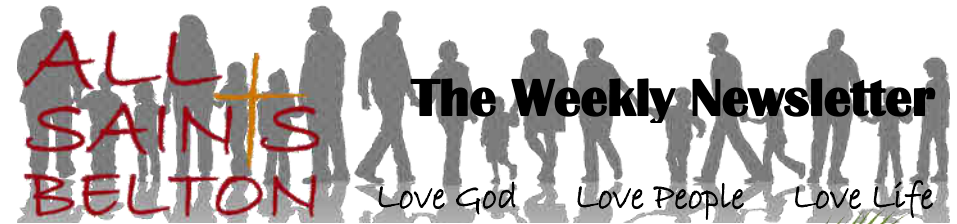
A Palm Sunday Prayer

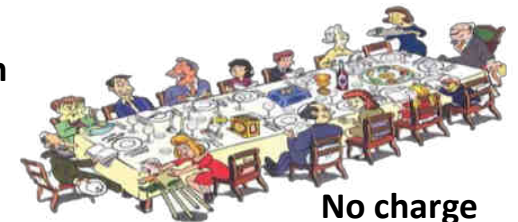
